RECIPE OF THE MONTH

September 22nd is the first day of Fall and soup season will soon be here! Try this comforting all time favorite!

6 c.	Water	8 oz.	Velveeta
10 oz.	Chopped Broccoli	$^{1}/_{4}$ c.	Margarine
$^{3}/_{4}$ c.	Chopped Onion	2 c.	Half & Half
2 tsp.	Salt	$^{1}/_{3}$ c.	Corn Starch
$^{1}/_{2}$ tsp	. Garlic Powder	$^{1}/_{2}$ c.	Cold Water
1 tsp.	Pepper		

Bring water to boil. Add broccoli and onion. Boil 12-15 minutes. Add seasonings and Velveeta cheese. Stir until melted. Add Half & Half. And stir until boiling. Mix cold water and corn starch and slowly add to soup stirring rapidly. Cook until soup is the consistency of heavy cream.
